**Dave Badgley**: Part V will be reorganized by categorizing Pipeline systems into logical groups such as; 1/ Solid wall, seamless, jointless, pipe liners, 2/ Cured in place such as the City of Los Angeles Ultra-Violet Light (UV) Cured-In-Place Lining, and 3/ Fold and Form liners - Dave Badgley will meet with Edward Arrington and Kent Welling of the City of Los Angeles who will chair a task force for those 3 pipeline systems and Dave Badgley will provide them with the names of who will chair each of the 3 Sub-Task committees. Other slip liner pipes such as jointed type

pipes requiring grouting etc., will be chaired by Los Angeles County Sanitation District.

Lance Grindle will contact Bill Mahoney to discuss posting approved changes to the Greenbook online since there is not enough material to officially put out a Supplement.

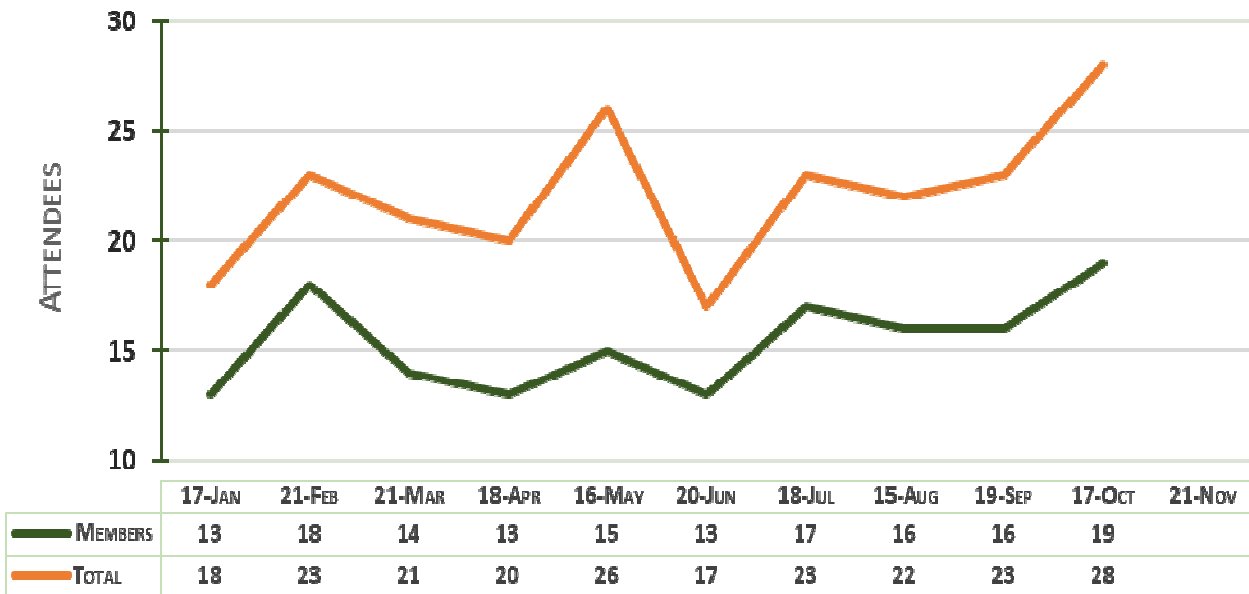
