- a) <u>APWA Co-Chairman's Report</u>:- Lance Grindle reported active work on review of the changes for the 2024 Greenbook. Lance also announced that he will be retiring at the end of February and may or may not continue as the Greenbook Committee Chair.
- **b)** <u>Secretary's Report:</u> Vin reported and shared the new suggested Greenbook price sheet. This document will be shared at April's Public Works Standards Inc. meeting for a vote.

- e) <u>Surface Materials and Methods Subcommittee Report:</u> Vinh Tran reported having no meetings with his Surface Material Subcommittee and also reported the following:
  - > The **Geosynthetics task** NO REPORT, they did not meet.
  - > The **Asphalt task force** met in December and are actively working on three items:
    - 1. Superpave gyratory process.
    - 2. Fiber reinforcement into asphalt.
    - 3. Requirements to audit the wrap content of the asphalt.
  - > The Concrete task force NO REPORT, they did not meet.
- f) Underground Materials and Methods Subcommittee Report: Gean Na reported the following:
  - ➤ Change 284 UM "Part Five" The subcommittee will meet monthly with people in the industry but are seeking support from agencies with good spec writers and wish that Dave Badgley continue supportting this task to get this decade old change completed.
  - ➤ Change 321 UM "Pickle Jar" This was approved at subcommittee and moved to Editorial.
  - Change 329 UM "Minimum Mandrel Diameter" table 306-7.8.3.2" Experts from Irvine Ranch Water District will be invited again to speak at next months meeting for discussions and hoping to move forward with a decision on this change.
  - Change 330 UM "18 Leg Mandrel" NO update but will be discussed at next months meeting. They may consider cancelling this change.
  - ➤ Change 331 UM "11-Month Warranty Reference" NO update but will be discussed at next months meeting. They may consider cancelling this change.
  - ➤ Change 332 UM "Causes for Rejection of Precast Reinforced Concrete Box (PRCB)" This change also in Editorial for their review/discussion.
  - Lastly, WL Plastics have about 1/2 dozen that they want to change related to HDPE pressure pipe. Change request will be sent to Ana.

- i) Editorial Standards Subcommittee Report: Charles Chen reported the following:
  - > No meeting was held in January. The next meeting will be in February with two changes to review.
- j) <u>Greenbook Retention Subcommittee Report:</u> Dan Peterson had no updates since no recent Caltrans communications reported.
- k) <u>Landscaping and Irrigation Subcommittee Report</u>: David Gallagher reported that the subcommittee has not met but information has been shared on a google drive with topics of soil. They hope to soon propose some changes.
- I) <u>Street Lighting and Traffic Systems Subcommittee Report:</u> Daniel Quintana reported meeting every other month with low turnout.
  - ➤ Topic of conversation has been the removal of Section Four from the Standard Plans and the correlation to Section 700 in the spec book with references that do not match. City of LA and San Diego both show interest in possibly bringing back those standard plans. David Mitchel offered assistance with this topic.
  - Caltrans is requiring agencies to use the latest standard plan for their projects that are federally or state funded.

  - Vin Wilhelm of BNI opened up a discussion to look into reinventing the Greenbook Website. He suggested to move it to WordPress, a platform that is more flexible and easy to update. Lance is in favor of making this an effort for the coming year.
