Privacy & Security Policy

Public Works Standards, Inc., publisher of the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (Greenbook), the Standard Plans for Public Works Construction and the Work Area Traffic Control Handbook (WATCH Handbook), recognizes the public's concern about privacy on the Internet. This privacy statement describes how information may be collected and used depending on your activities at this website.

Information Collected and Stored Automatically

We may collect and store information for statistical purposes. For example, we may count the number of visitors to the different sections of our site to help us make them more useful. If You Send Us Personal Information

• E-mail:

When you may be asked to provide information:

We may ask you to provide information to us. For example, people asking about proposals being reviewed or adopted by us or one of our committees may be asked to provide their names, addresses, e-mail addresses and other pertinent information to ensure processing and delivery of the information requested. Other information may be collected at these sites through questionnaires, feedback forms, or other means, to enable us to determine a visitor's interests, with the goal of providing better service.

Surveys:

From time to time, we may ask you to participate in a survey. We will only retain the information that you provide in response to the survey.

• Changes to Personal Information:

Security

Personally Identifiable Information:

We are committed to data security and the data quality of personally identifiable information that is either available from or collected by our website. We have taken reasonable precautions to protect such information from loss, misuse or alteration. We operate "secure data networks" protected by industry standard firewalls and password protection systems. Only authorized individuals have access to the information provided by our users. Sensitive information submitted by users is transmitted by Secure Socket Layer ("SSL") technology. SSL is a security technology designed to enable your browser to send to and receive information from another server in an encrypted format. Your browser's security icon, usually located in the bottom status bar of your browser window, reflects the security condition of the browser. The lock icon indicates that your browser is communicating over a secured link. All information you provide to us in this manner is stored securely, subject to

legal disclosure requirements.

Passwords:

When you are finished with those applications that are password protected, you should exit the page.

Cookies:
