2. The minutes from the June 8, 2006 meeting were approved as distributed.

3. Old Business –

A. Pervious Concrete -

Andy Youngs and Tom Tietz of the California Nevada Cement Promotion Council presented a program on their experience with pervious concrete in the central California area. Information disseminated included:

- PowerPoint Presentation of numerous projects using pervious concrete
- Discussion of CNCPC's recommended specifications
- Discussion of the history of pervious concrete
- Discussion of the placing procedures recommended by CNCPC

Andy will “re-tool” our Draft 8 of Pervious Concrete and discuss at the next meeting.

B. Change No. 155NS - Fly ash and the R-Factor -

The Change was returned from the Editorial Standards Subcommittee with a recommendation to accept at the last Main Committee Meeting and is currently on a 30-day hold for review. The Committee will vote on acceptance into the 2007 Supplement at the July 20, 2006 meeting.

C. Aggregates –

Mike discussed the results of the first Aggregate Task Force meeting held on June 28, 2006 at Solomon Colors. The next Task Force meeting will be held on August 9, 2006 at 9:00 AM at Solomon Colors.

D. Class N Pozzolan –

The latest modification of 201-1.1.1 was distributed and discussed. With only minor suggested changes, the Group decided to review and discuss the proposal at next month's meeting.

E. Fibers –

Jeff presented verbiage regarding Fibers which states:

201-1.2.7 Fiber Reinforcement

Fiber reinforcement specified in the Special Provisions or approved by the Engineer shall conform to the specifications in 201-2.3.

This language was acceptable to the Group and suggested it be proposed to the Surface Subcommittee for acceptance into the 2007 Supplement (if timing permits).

F. Color –

Rod did not complete the modification of Pat's proposal regarding the addition of color to 201-1.1.1 and will have it available at the next meeting for review and discussion.

4. New Business –

A. Mike requested Ed Chapman of Vulcan be included in future meeting notifications (Done).

B. It was noted that Section 200-2.2.3 and Table 200-2.2.3 (A) were omitted from the 2006 printing of the Greenbook and will be reinserted via the 2007 Supplement.

C. Griff presented the latest E-News from NRMCA (included with these minutes).
