3. Old Business –

A. Change No. 176NS – Pervious Concrete –

Jerry confirmed Change No. 176NS is still with the Editorial Subcommittee.

B. Aggregates –

The Task Force is actively encouraging additional participation from some of the major aggregate producers in the region that have participated on a limited basis or have not been involved at all. The next meeting will be on January 29th at the Solomon Colors conference room. The Task Force will review proposed aggregate gradation changes and vote on the changes to date.

C. Change No. 184NS - Class N Pozzolan / Fibers / Color –

Jerry confirmed Change No. 184NS is also still with the Editorial Subcommittee.

D. Change No. 190NS - Grout Section 202 Modifications –

The Change was approved by the Surface Subcommittee and forwarded to the Editorial Standards Subcommittee for their review.

E. Self Leveling, Self Consolidating, Zero Slump & Fast Setting concretes –

Javier presented his latest revision of the Draft Proposal and it was reviewed and discussed by the Group. Several suggested modifications will be incorporated into the Draft by Javier and presented to the Group at the next meeting.

4. New Business –

- Ken Parks briefed the Group on the current change/trend within the concrete community to avoid the term “mix design” and to consider using language such as “mix proportions” or “mix properties” instead. Griff informed the Group that the City of Los Angeles requires the term “mix design” to be used on the submittal document. Ken will provide the Group with additional information on this issue at future meetings.
- Don reported the State of California (CalTrans) is NOT approving aggregate documentation unless the specific project name, pit number identification, and contract number are included in the report/submittal. This new requirement is creating additional turn-around time to an already slow process.
