 - b. Change No. 322 SM: Portland Limestone Cement

 - ii. Item will be advanced to Surface and Materials committee
 - c. Interlocking Concrete Pavers
 - i. Change number has been applied for from BNI, will begin reviewing next meeting
 - d. Potential New Changes:
 - i. Alternative SCMs: It was determined to split this effort into separate proposals to cover Slag & Ground Glass. Natural Pozzolan can be handled within Change No. 304 SM
 - e. Potential new/upcoming work items:
 - i. Lightweight Cellular Concrete
 - ii. Carbon Capture
 - f. Sustainability Topics: A discussion of the CALGreen Carbon Reduction Collaborative Workshop took place. Effort focuses on reducing carbon in building materials. Link shared with recording of the June meeting.
