4. Old Business
 - a. Change No. 300SM
 - Approved at main committee
5. New Business
 - a. Mrs. Corina Wong has replaced Tom William as chair for the group.
 - b. Reviewed the process by which changes are initiated through the Greenbook committees with the subcommittee
 - c. New Change No. 313SM for CIR (Van Truong/LA County Sponsor) assigned by main committee.
 - Waiting on draft for review by group. Clarence Su will investigate status of draft.
 - d. Latest version of AB 1035 review and discussed as related to asphalt materials
 - CT vs Greenbook:
 - i. CT allows RAP up to 25% binder replacement
 1. RAP content subject to binder grade adjustment based when RAP binder replacement exceeds 15%.
 - ii. Greenbook does not cap the amount of RAP to be used in HMA
 1. RAP content prescribed by local agencies
 2. HMA may only contain more than 20% RAP when allowed by local agency
 3. HMA mix design with more than 25% RAP subject to binder grade verification testing
 - e. Superpave for local agencies. (Status: Call for more supplier test data for review)
 - f. Change No. 301SM.
 - Will request latest version of 301SM from Erik Updyke for distribution to group

- g. RAP aggregate for micro-surfacing and slurry seal changes did not make it into the last change to 300SM. A draft change document has been formulated by Erik but it is waiting on comments by industry.
 - Will need new change number
 - h. Waiting on a draft for berm mix specification. To be sponsored by Blaine of Orange County.
 - i. 10% RAP in Asphalt Rubber Hot Mix. Don Vivant provided update that CT has started a statewide pilot program. Limited production data has been produced.
 - j. MAC10/15 TR specification. Pending sponsorship/draft specifications.
