- A. Change 125 NS – Slurry / REAS. - Draft specifications were distributed to sub group for comments. Joe Vicelja is waiting for round robin test results. Next meeting is Oct. 18, at the Los Angeles County Lab.
- B. Change 173 NS - 302-1. Oiled Roadways. - Task force agreed to send this change to the Surface Subcommittee.
- E. CRUMAC – Distributed change with Erik Updyke’s revisions. It was agreed to leave “Dry Process” in the title. Revision was made to temperature at time of delivery to jobsite.
- F. TMAC – Distributed change with Steve Burhans’ revisions. “Tire rubber modified paving asphalt” replaced “asphalt rubber binder”. Pascal will check on temperature requirements. Joe Vicelja suggested a second table in 203-14.3.2 for TMAC using dense graded mix. Steve Burhans will research dense graded mix designs and asphalt contents.

****Note** TMAC specification was distributed to APA Rubberized Asphalt Committee. It was suggested at that meeting that TMAC required a different gap gradation than ARHM. They will research and forward comments to this Task Force. ****
