3. Old Business
- A. Change 125 NS – Slurry / REAS. – The change is on 30 day hold at the Surface Subcommittee. Lance Allan brought up a concern on the latex used for cationic emulsions. Lance and Tom Williams will research and revise latex section if needed.
- B. Change 188 NS – 203-11.3 Gap Graded gradation revision – This change was rejected and reported to the Main Committee.
- C. Change 189 NS – 203-11.4.1 Viscosity test procedure – California Lab Procedure #11 was distributed and compared to revised procedure in the Greenbook. Lab procedure seems to address 5 of the 6 reasons for the revision. Buddy will take LP 11 to the APA – RAC meeting for discussion.
- D. Porous Asphalt Concrete – There was continued discussion on the need for the specification. Any pervious or porous pavement requires a drainage system design. This change will be specification only and not design of whole drainage system.
- E. Change 191 NS - 203-6/7 Recycled Asphalt Concrete. – The change was presented to Surface Subcommittee and voted on to forward to Editorial Subcommittee for review.
- H. Job Mix formulas – In the absence of Don Vivant the proposed change will be discussed at next meeting.
