- B. Change 189 NS – 203-11.4.1 Viscosity test procedure – It was agreed to reference LP-11. Wording will be revised. Discussion will be put on hold until Caltrans completes review test methods and will be submitted for 2010 Supplement.
- C. Porous Asphalt Concrete – Task force is leaning towards Caltrans OGAC gradation specifications. It was suggested to have Jim St. Martin provide his presentation on porous asphalt to the group at a future meeting.
- D. Change 191 NS - 203-6/7 Recycled Asphalt Concrete. – Approved for 2009 Greenbook. Subgroup (Don Vivant, Pascal Mascarenhas, and Layne Richens) will start on 203-7 update.
- E. Change 194 NS - Job Mix formulas – Change will be sent with minutes for comments. If no comments then it will be sent to Surface Subcommittee in September.
