2. Minutes of August 4, 2010 were approved.

3. Old Business

- A. Change 125 NS – Slurry / REAS. – Updated change was taken to Surface Subcommittee and approved to resubmit to Editorial Standards Subcommittee.
- B. Change 189 NS – 203-11.4.1 Viscosity test procedure – Discussed email “discussion” regarding change. It was agreed to submit change to Surface Subcommittee.
- C. Change 205 NS - Warm Mix Asphalt – Change is at the Surface Subcommittee. Question at Main Committee whether a sponsor is required. Mike Costello will be approached to see if County of Orange will be willing to sponsor change.
- D. Change 207 NS - Porous Asphalt Concrete – Change is at Editorial Standards Subcommittee. Erik Updyke questioned acceptance criteria. Producers felt that if AC mix met requirements then there shouldn't be a problem meeting infiltration specification. Task Force agreed that Porous Asphalt Concrete specification is needed rather than just an Open Graded mix.
- E. 203-7 Recycled Asphalt Concrete. – Will hold discussion on combined 203-6 / 203-7 until Joe Vicelja is present.
- F. Part 4 – Discussed change to note after Table 400-4.3 (B). Add wording in 2003 Greenbook to allow 30 S-value for III D and III F mixes.

- A. Ajideh Hossein questioned air void specifications for C1 and D1 mixes. Buddy will survey other agencies for use of these mixes.
- B. Morey Bouzari suggested a couple of editorial changes to 203-6.
