### A. Supplement/Edition Changes

- 3) Change No 199NS – Following discussion the Change was approved and will be sent to the Editorial Standards Subcommittee for review and comment.

### B. Asphalt Task Force

Buddy Coover reported on the August 5, 2009 meeting:

- 1) Change No 125NS – Remains with the Editorial Standards Subcommittee for review. The Task Force requested a final review of the Change prior to submission to the Main Committee.
- 2) Change No 189NS – The Task Force is reviewing CalTrans and ASTM procedures for a “best fit” into the Greenbook.
- 3) Change No 205NS – In progress.

### C. Concrete Ad Hoc Group

Rod Elderton reported on the August 13, 2009 meeting:

- 2) Draft #10 of the Self Consolidating Concrete specification reviewed. Draft #11 will be discussed at the next meeting.
- 3) Discussions on Rapid Strength Concrete held. The inclusion of CTS “type” cement is already in the Greenbook. Progress made on other areas and more discussions to follow in future meetings.
- 4) Rip Rap spec in Greenbook compare to CalTrans and the Group decided they are the same in content.

- 5) ACI & NRMCA sent responses to the EPA regarding the classification of fly ash as a “hazardous material”. Topic was discussed and copies will be made available to interested individuals.
- 6) South Coast AQMD is “stepping-up” bag house inspections.
