A. Asphalt Task Force

Buddy Coover reported on the September 1, 2010 meeting:

- 1) Change No 189NS was completed at the last Task Force meeting and presented for review. The proposal was placed on a 30-day hold for review and will be discussed at the next meeting.
- 2) The Editorial Standards Subcommittee contacted the Task Force with questions and comments regarding 207NS. The Task Force discussed the comments and decided to leave the change as submitted.
- 3) Continuing investigation on RAP and investigation of Part 4.
- 4) Task Force held further discussions regarding air voids for C-1 & D-1 mixes covered by 213. Buddy will address the Main Committee regarding the soliciting of input from the industry on the use of C-1 and D-1 mixes.

B. Concrete Ad Hoc Group
